

Isle Harbor Good Neighbor Policy

In the interest of creating an environment in which we can all enjoy our experiences at Isle Harbor, the following policies need to be followed:

- Respect the property of others. Do not expand your play area at the expense of someone else without their permission. This includes using someone else's lawn or driving across someone's property. (See map of Isle Harbor)
- Quiet time is between the hours of **10PM and 7AM**. Avoid excessively loud and disruptive behavior at all times.
- **Direct supervision by a responsible adult** is required when people under age 16 use four wheelers (ATVs), golf carts, and snowmobiles. All State of Minnesota regulations for the use of ATVs by those under age 16 shall apply to Isle Harbor.
- The posted speed limit is **15 mph**.
- If you use the fish-cleaning house, clean up after yourself. Put the fish remains in a plastic bag, seal it up, and put it in the freezer. Also, wash down your work area when you are done.
- If you are involved in the rental of a home or cabin with access to Isle Harbor, you must be sure the renters receive a copy of this policy so they are aware of our expectations.
- There are two boat slips under each metal canopy. If you share a metal canopy with another owner, please keep your watercraft and/or boat lift within your half of the space.
- The use of motorized vehicles on the "beach trail" is restricted to the following and used at own risk:
 - Beach access to unload/load passengers or personal items by ATV/UTV or golf cart
 - Ice access by ATV/UTV, snowmobile, or vehicle

The intention of these guidelines is not meant to be unduly restrictive. We strive to maintain a safe environment and to eliminate activities that infringe on the enjoyment of others within Isle Harbor.
